

Public Information May Report

The PI committee plans to purchase Living Sober books for the Suffolk County libraries to distribute to each branch. This is being done in conjunction with CPC and SIA. Each of the 63 branches will receive one Big Book and one LS book. There is a budgetary motion on the floor at this months meeting.

The SIA liaison has offered the PI committee a collection of Grapevine magazines that have been donated. We plan to find ways to make use of them.

The sectors we are looking to target are social service offices like Child Protective Services. CPS workers go into homes where alcoholism could be a variable that they encounter. We are considering which pamphlets would be suitable for them to offer.

Employee assistance programs are another area that we plan to approach. They are usually trained in alcoholism and often recommend AA, so we're still trying to figure out what we could offer that would be helpful.
