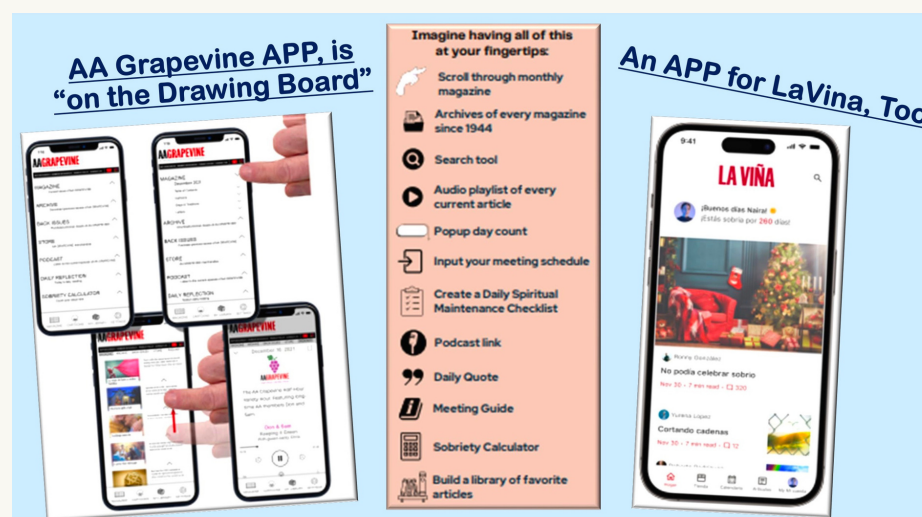


Good Evening Everyone,
