Workshops presented at all levels shall be communicated to DCMC and ALT DCMC. (DCMC and ALT DCMC has the right within concept X to decide if the workshop should be presented to the county for approval.

Along with:

- Title of the workshop
- If we are co-sponsoring with another entity (Intergroup, SENY, Al-anon etc.)
- If we are being co-sponsored what is the other entity contributing
- Date of workshop
- Time
- Location
- Any costs involved.
- Confirmed with Area Calendar and County calendar nothing else is happening
- If you have a draft copy of the flyer, please submit for approval

Excluded are the Standing committee chairs of the Unity Breakfast, Big Meeting, LISTS, Share a Thon, and Liaison as workshops as it states Concept X -Service Authority matches the Service Responsibility.
