SUFFOLK GENERAL SERVICE CHAIR REPORT



Good evening, Suffolk Family,

It's been an amazing month. Founders Day was 6/10/24, and Grapevine is celebrating its 80th anniversary. Thank you, John V, for giving my report last month. I could not attend the assembly —that's what alternates are for, and she will speak about her experience! I can tell you that the printing of the full conference report is on schedule (which could change). The digital completion date is 8/5, the print date is 8/14, and the ship date is 8/21.

Since the last meeting, I attended the Nassau Unity Breakfast, a PI Workshop, where we discussed strategies for public information and outreach, and a Cooperation with Professional Community meeting. On July 17, there will be a virtual meeting for the Nurses for Recovery. It's a meeting to empower Healthcare Professionals about Alcoholics Anonymous. If anyone is interested, I can share the flyer. I found out that Area 15 is submitting a Proposed Agenda Item stating:

"We propose an **additional** appendix to the 5th edition of the Big Book titled "A Professional's View for the 21st Century," which would feature strong scientific evidence validating the therapeutic effectiveness of the AA program in helping chronic alcoholics achieve and maintain sobriety. We further propose that this professional view be written by Dr. Kelly and Humphreys. "
